

1. FRAMEWORK: THE ORIGIN OF THE INCLUSION POLICY

2. THE CHILD BENEFIT IN THE NATIONAL MINIMUM INCOME SCHEME

Minimum Income Scheme: Guaranteed income for households

- 565€ per month for a single adult (above extreme poverty threshold for 2022)
- 905€ per month for two-parent two-children household (above poverty threshold for 2022)
- 1029€ per month for single-parent two-children household (above poverty threshold for 2022)


Child benefit: fixed amount per child

- 115€ per month for each child between 0 and 3 years old
- 80,5€ per month for each child between 3 and 6 years old
- 57,50€ per month for each child between 6 and 18 years old

Eligibility: under 3 times Guaranteed income for MIS

Previous Child benefit: 24€ per month per child

Beneficiaries of MIS (children), monthly payment






Almost 600.000 children are covered at this moment by the MIS (only basic MIS, MIS+CB, only CB)

34 pilot inclusion projects (itineraries) targeted to Minimum Income Scheme beneficiaries and people in vulnerable situations





5. THE SOCIAL INVESTMENT WITH HIGHEST RETURN

In this large study, close to 1 out of 2 policies reviewed present very large return, and many close to infinite. Child Health and Education, College Child or the “Movement To Opportunity” (MTO) are the global categories with the highest return



Large value zone:

- Returns on the order of several times the incurred budgetary costs.
- Even in many cases with negative costs (when subtracted futures tax externalities from the base budgetary cash-outs) and an infinite return

Low or negative value zone:

- Policies that are a mere financial money transfer (MVPF=1) or even negative or very negative



LEALTAD
